



Selection Criteria

- ✳ The video is 1 minute duration or less
- ✳ The video is respectful and does not contain any offensive language, nudity, or hate speech
- ✳ The video is relevant to the key question and the chosen theme
- ✳ The video content will help inform policies and services supporting the wellbeing of children and young people
- ✳ The video footage and any audio is clear
- ✳ All required consents and application information have been provided
- ✳ Videos that include content that could be traumatising to other children and young people will not be accepted.

Assessment process

A Reference Group of young people is working with Families Australia. Members will work with the Conference Reference Group to assess the videos against the selection criteria.

We will try to make sure we accept videos that are representative across all themes.

All videos that are accepted will be used to inform service delivery but only a selection will be shown at the Conference.

If your video is not accepted, we will let you know why.

- ✳ Any image or video that is published online on the Child Aware Conference and Families Australia websites can be copied and shared without the knowledge of the person that uploaded it. Once your video is published, we may not be able to retrieve or delete it if you withdraw your permission after publishing.
